Programme Content

- Intimate/ Dating Partners Class -

Target:

- · 18 years old or above (both men and women)
- Having frequent conflicts (or even violence) with intimate partner

Objective:

Through 6-hour educational programme, help partipants to have reflection on partner conflicts and violence, establish non-violent communication and improve relationship with intimate partner

Content:

Emotional management skill, Understanding of impact of conflicts (including violence) on intimate partner relationship (or family), Use of peaceful means to resolve conflictual communication between partners

Format:

Short talks, sharing, discussions, activities

No. of sessions:

4 (approximately once per week, 1.5 hours per session)

- Family Fun Day -

Target:

Family/ intimate partner having frequent conflict

Objective:

To improve relationship and cohesion with partner/ family members, and enhance capacity on coping with stress due to conflict

Content:

Learning of stress management and non-violent communication through recreational activities, experiential programmes and short talks

- Children/ Adolescent Class -

Target:

Children/ Adolescents witnessing or being exposed to family conflict

Objective:

Through 4-hour educational programme, facilitate participants to ventilate negative emotions, and enhance resilience and problem-solving capacity in addressing family conflict

Content:

Handling of negative emotions arising from family conflict, Skills of self-protection and problem coping enhancement

Format:

Games, exercises, sharing

No. of sessions:

3-4 (approximately once per week, 1-1.5 hours per session)

To facilitate early identification towards targets in need, and raise the public awareness and understanding on partner violence and dating violence

Format:

Talks, exhibitions, community booths

Introduction

Since 2013, with the support from Social Welfare Department, our agency has been delivering the project 'Peace Campus' under 'Educational Programme on Stopping Domestic Violence' (EPSDV) in Eastern Kowloon providing 6-hour training course for participants who had potentially or already used family violence. The aim of the project is to enhance the participants' emotional management skills, understanding the influences of family conflict and violence; and use of peaceful ways to solve the conflict with intimate partner.

Start from October 2018, with the support by Social Welfare Department, EPSDV has been extended and named as 'Support Programme for Enhancing Peaceable Relationship', our project scope of 'Peace Campus' has been expanded to cover the supportive programmes for children witnessing or being exposed to family conflict (or even family violence).

Objectives

- To learn how to handle partner conflicts in a non-violent way, and improve intimate partner relationship and family relationship:
- To support children witnessing or being exposed to intimate partner conflict (or even violence) by enhancing their resilience and life skills in addressing family conflict:
- To raise public awareness and understanding towards intimate partner violence and dating violence.

- General public with interest in understanding more about intimate partner violence and dating violence:
- Regardless of gender, language, ethnicity, sexual orientation and gender identification.
